Contingency plan for the Coronavirus trafficking program in Spain

The resources of the Adoratrices network in Spanish territory have been declared by the Government as an essential service during the state of alarm caused by the Coronavirus pandemic.

The projects of Adoratrices will continue, therefore, to serve all resident and non-resident women (professional assistance via telematics, if possible), as well as welcoming new women who meet our care profiles.

Residential places for International Protection and Trafficking, as well as places for victims of trafficking, will be available, while we will take care of and follow the recommendations of the Ministry of Health and respect and comply with the exceptional provisions of the Government during the state of alarm.



The priority is to address the urgent needs for shelter and assistance of potential victims of trafficking, making as few contacts as possible so as not to endanger the health of the individuals and workers and to prevent the spread of the virus.

From January 30 to March 6, Sr. Teresa Valenzuela, Superior General, visited the Japanese delegation together with Sr. Micaela Tanigaichi.

The visit to the delegation of Asia by Sr. Teresa concluded with a meeting with all the superiors of the various communities of the delegation of Japan.

"I would like to thank all the communities for their welcome and their attention to Sr. Micaela and to me. We are returning to Rome, supported by the fraternity of each sister", Sr. Teresa appointed.

The visit allowed the Superior General to know first hand the reality of the Congregation in this geographical area; its projects, the difficulties, the joys, the ecclesial reality of each zone, etc.

Language was not a problem for her to share her daily life with each community and to feel that the Adorers do not understand borders.

Sister Ana Fons, author of the drawing for the VIII General Conference, helps us "read" its meaning:

International presence

"Our presence embraces the whole world and therefore there is an Adorer's presence at sunrise, at sunset, in a place where the land is the protagonist and in a place where the sea is the protagonist.

Circularity

"It is a circularity that speaks to me of the form of the traditional bread that we consecrate and that we have in the monstrance in which we place ourselves before it for worship. Hence the circular target."

Hearts

"The hearts, all centralized and dispersed at the same time, advance, seek centrality; they are connected. All in communion. All hearts have a yellowish presence at their center which means: together to transform, together to walk, together to adore, together to be invaded by the new spirit.

The community of Valencia hosted a congregational formation meeting for the sisters of the first adult stage. The meeting was organized by the General Government through the area of Formation.

The sisters who participated came from various parts of the world: Bolivia, Colombia, Vietnam, Japan, Togo, Italy, Portugal, Spain and India.

ADORER PRESENCE AT THE NATIONAL CONGRESS OF YOUNG PEOPLE OF COLOMBIA


