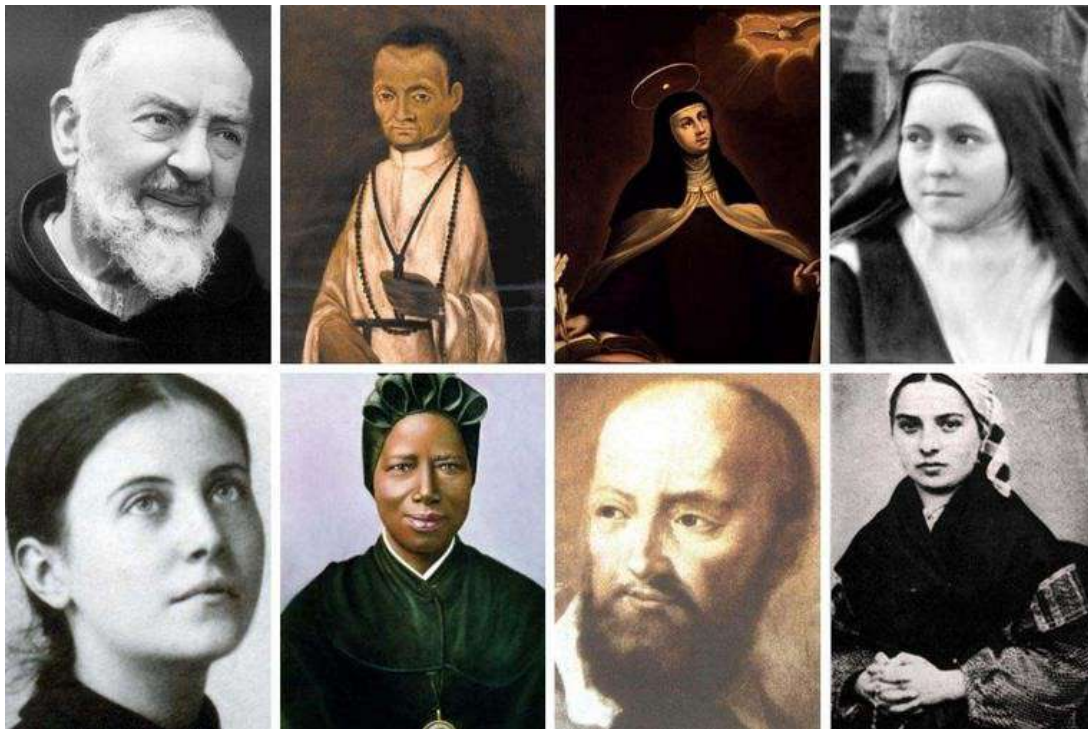

The empathy map invites us to consider the needs and perspectives of each service's beneficiaries, allowing us to update our perceptions and assessments while also listening to those of our colleagues in other services. After this work, we will formulate a "customer corridor," which is also a tool that allows us to trace the entire itinerary of the woman when she enters the project, identifying the services we provide, the critical points, and areas for improvement. It is a very good opportunity to rethink and question the knowledge that we need to update and build an intervention experience for women adapted to their specific needs.

**Abstract:** From Proyecto Esperanza, in the framework of the RECTP, we appreciate and value very positively the meeting held today for a working session with the Secretary of State for Migration of the Ministry of Inclusion, Social Security, and Migration. This is the body in charge of developing the migration policy defined by the government in terms of immigration and integration of immigrants, and our colleague Eva Sancha, Head of the Legal Service, participated in the meeting. The working session aimed to unify criteria regarding residence and work permits for exceptional circumstances due to personal situations for victims of human trafficking. 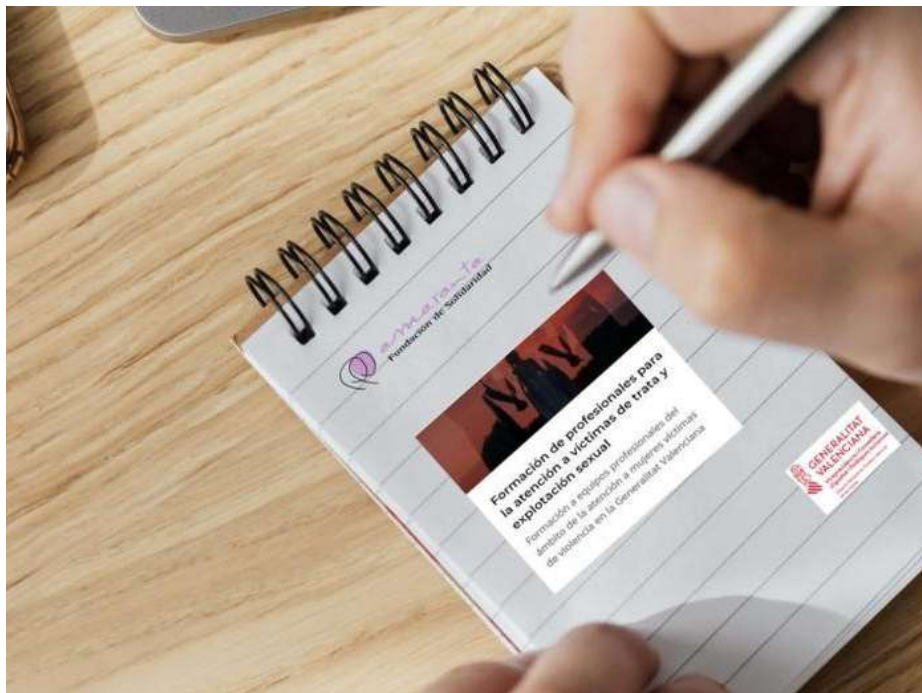

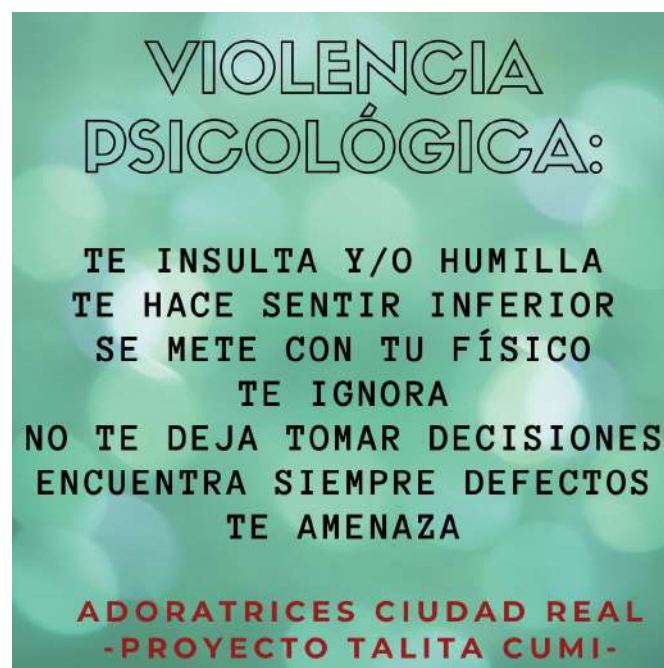

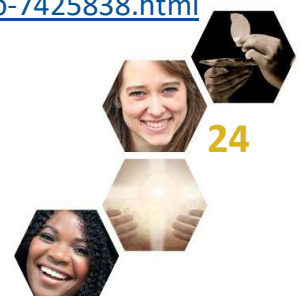
