Abstract: Yesterday we concluded the last webinar of the course on Detection, identification and care for victims of human trafficking for the purpose of sexual exploitation, funded by the Directorate General for Equality of the Community of Madrid in the framework of the Madrid Strategy against Trafficking. The course was attended by 162 students from the four target professional associations, the Professional Association of Social Education, the Official Association of Social Work, the Official Association of Psychology and the Lawyers' Association of Madrid. A staff of 6 teaching professionals, specialised in each of the branches taught, has been involved, with the invaluable technical support of the virtual classroom of the Amaranta Foundation, to which we would like to express our thanks. In the 8 hours of live webinars and the forty hours of teaching on the platform, we have tried to transmit an updated vision of the framework in which the phenomenon of trafficking is currently operating, as well as our specialised intervention model in each of the areas addressed. Many thanks to all the people who have made this project possible once again, particularly to the Directorate General for Equality, for trusting us once again, and we hope to see you in future training activities!.

Abstract: Human trafficking is the third most lucrative illegal business in the world. In 2019, the CNDH documented 5,245 victims of this crime, 85% of whom are women and girls; three out of four cases were for the purpose of sexual exploitation.
