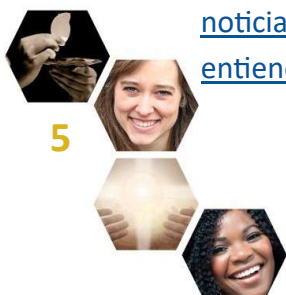

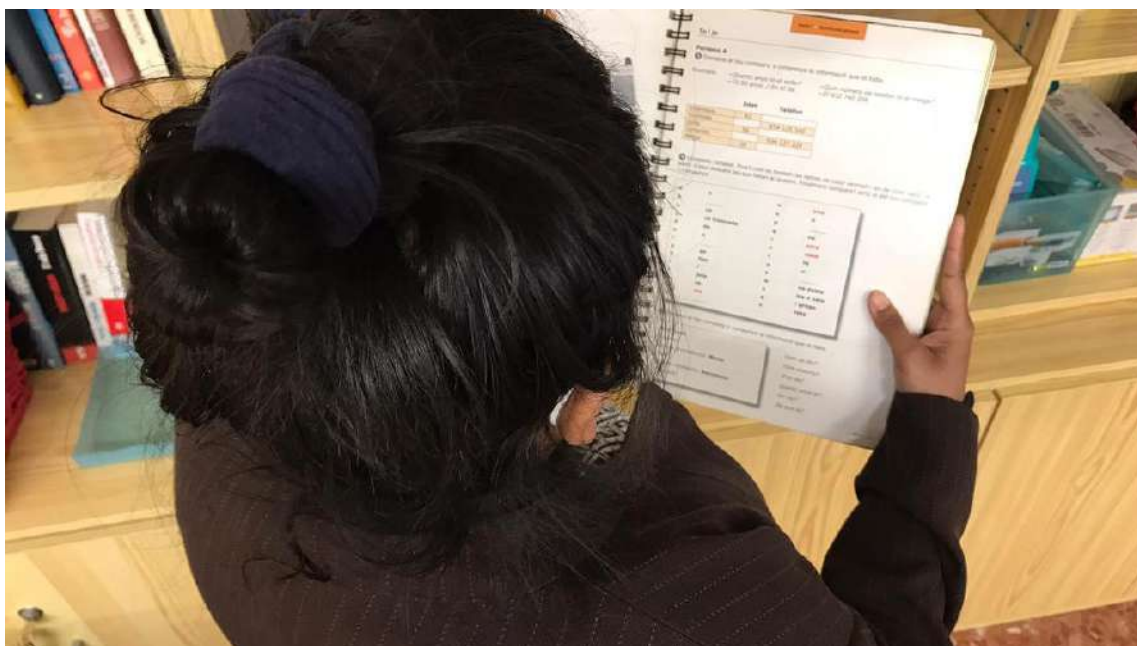

Abstract: On 8M we released the video of #Confuerzaregresé but do you know the story behind this protest song made by women survivors of trafficking in the process of recovery at SICAR. The song has 1 lead vocal but the singer wanted to write 1 lyric for ALL women, beyond those who, like her and her fellow survivors, have been trafficked. She was inspired by her own life story but also collected the experiences of other survivors. Once the lyrics were ready, she presented them to her colleagues and translated them into English so that those women who were not yet familiar with Spanish and Catalan could understand them. After the presentation, the level of enthusiasm in the group grew and they considered accompanying the powerful lyrics with a video with collective ideas, the result of which can be seen in the link.

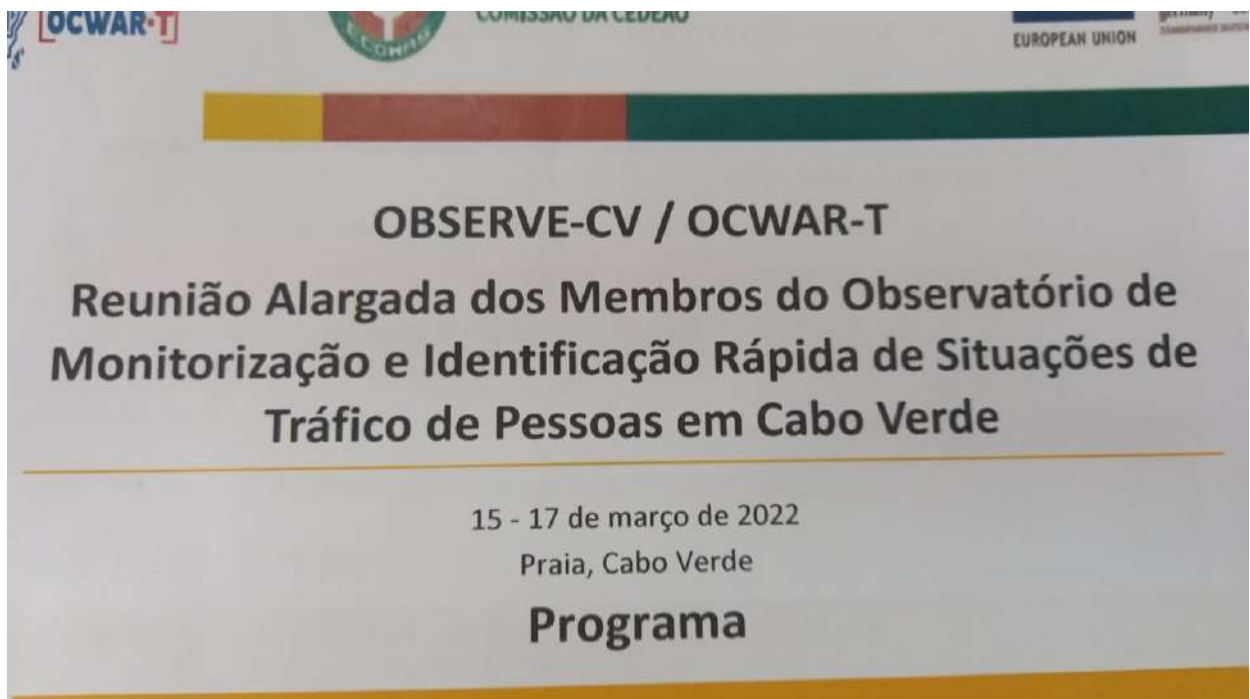
