

Abstract: From Proyecto Esperanza, we are following with great concern the situation in Ukraine, and we want to express our solidarity with the Ukrainian people. As an associate member of La Strada International, we met last Friday to see how we can be more useful in this context, and we are in contact with our colleagues from La Strada Ukraine. War and the forced displacement that accompanies it, as we are seeing these days, increase the vulnerability of the population to human trafficking, and are used by traffickers who take advantage of this situation of uncertainty and desperation. At this time, and always, we call for ensuring that all people have the right to seek asylum and find safe refuge in another country, as well as respect for human rights and international humanitarian law. As the UN High Commissioner for Refugees has said, there are no winners in war.







Abstract: Our multidisciplinary team is made up of 25 professionals who intervene with survivors throughout the entire process with an approach based on human rights, gender, intersectional, crosscultural, and resilience. Having a clear gender perspective is relevant because we must understand why women in the world are discriminated against, in a situation of inequality and subordination. Based on biological aspects, it has been legitimized and naturalized that women must always be at the service of others, that they must be caregivers and that they must remain in the private sphere. A series of attitudes, behaviors, values, feelings, needs, ideas, abilities, affections, functions, and roles that are supposed to be natural for all women have been constructed and perpetuated through socializing agents such as parents, family, school, media, soap operas, stories, and films. At the same time, based again on biology, it is constructed and justified that men are aggressive, with irrepressible needs, superior to women, and therefore they should have dominance and authority. They possess political, sexual, social, and cultural hegemony.

Abstract: El pasado miércoles 2 de marzo en el marco del Día Internacional de las mujeres, hemos compartido con el Colectivo Diversas de Navalcarnero la conferencia: La trata de mujeres con fines de explotación. Violación de los derechos de las mujeres. Fue una oportunidad para señalar, una vez más, que la trata de personas supone una violación de derechos humanos que no es neutral en cuanto al género. Tal y como afirma la Declaración de Beijing, la trata es una forma de violencia basada en el género. Y no sólo lo es porque la mayor parte de las víctimas son mujeres y niñas, sino también porque determinadas formas de trata suponen, en sí mismas, violencia contra la mujer por el hecho de serlo. Las formas de trata para explotación que tienen una incidencia desproporcionada en mujeres y niñas son, como mínimo la trata para explotación sexual (comercial o no), incluida la pornografía, la trata para explotación laboral en sectores fuertemente feminizados, como el servicio doméstico o el trabajo en "salones de belleza" o en determinados sectores de la agricultura, la trata para matrimonio forzado, y la trata para la gestación de bebés para su posterior venta o para adopciones ilegales.


