

Abstract: Yesterday we were providing formation at the reception Centre, for Ukrainian people seeking temporary care, attention protección in Pozuelo de Alarcón. We attended together with @inclusiongob the three entities that specialized in detecting victims of trafficking: @diaconia, APRAMP, and @ProyectoEsperanzaAdoratrices. We held two formation sessions aimed at the staff of the Social Work Unit of @inclusiongob and the organization @Accem, which manages the center. In terms of the contents addressed, we recalled:

- What is trafficking.
- The different profiles of victims and traffickers.
- The different scenarios and purposes of trafficking.
- Indicators for detection.
- · Case studies.
- Procedure to follow in case of indications to contact specialized entities so that they can assess the needs of the victims and offer them protection.

We welcome the opportunity to further strengthen links and networking to fight trafficking in a more effective and coordinated way.


