Abstract: Fundación Telefónica recently presented the Book on the Digital Transformation of the Third Sector. Carlos Palacios, Director of Social Action, and Volunteering at Fundación Telefónica, talks about the objective of digitally strengthening the social entities and increasing their impact in a society marked by the technological revolution. Proyecto Esperanza Adoratrices offers integral support to women who have suffered from human trafficking. Between 1999 and 2021, this project has helped almost 20,000 women of 74 nationalities. Red Inicia is a project that was launched on the COVID-19 pandemic and continues to expand its action. We interviewed Iris, one of the young women involved in the project, and Myriam Pérez, the CEO of Red Inicia.

Abstract: Associations and NGOs have been warning for months about the increase in human trafficking caused by the conflict between Russia and Ukraine. Trafficking networks are recruiting women and children at the borders, taking advantage of the wave of solidarity, and posing as volunteers. Although human trafficking increases in conflict situations, this is not a new situation in Eastern Europe. For years, these countries have been the source of most trafficked women in Europe. A 2010 report by the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) highlighted that most of the victims of human trafficking detected in Europe in recent years came from the Balkans, Romania, Bulgaria, Ukraine, the Russian Federation and Moldova. It has been a serious problem for years and has had to be tackled by the European Commission.

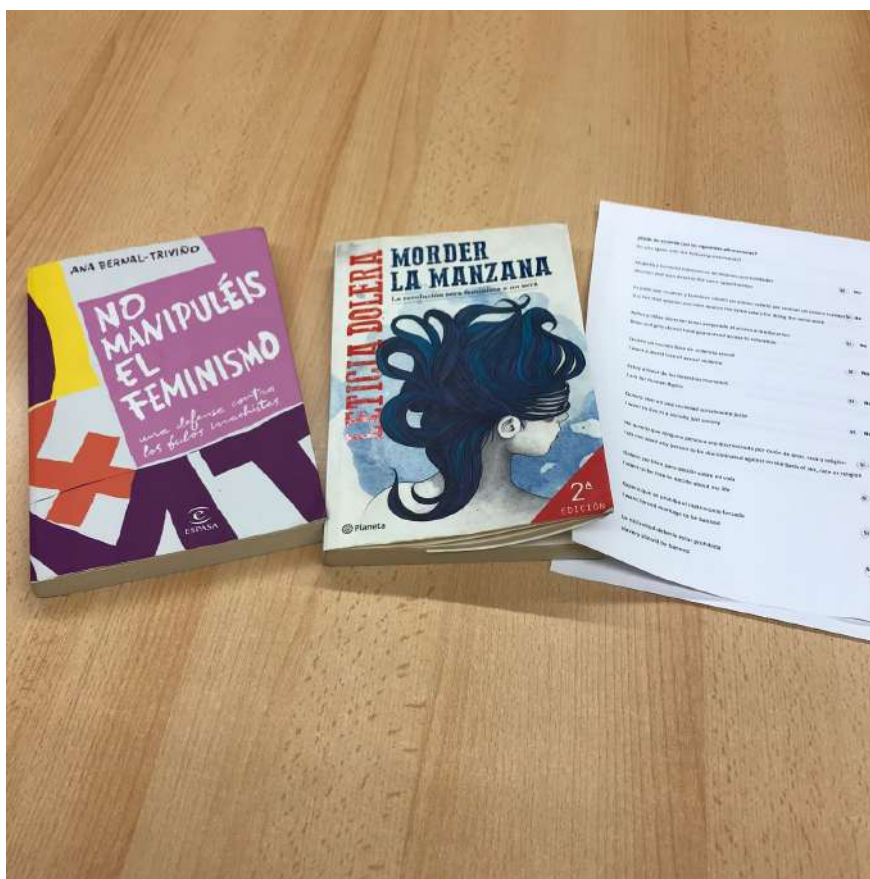

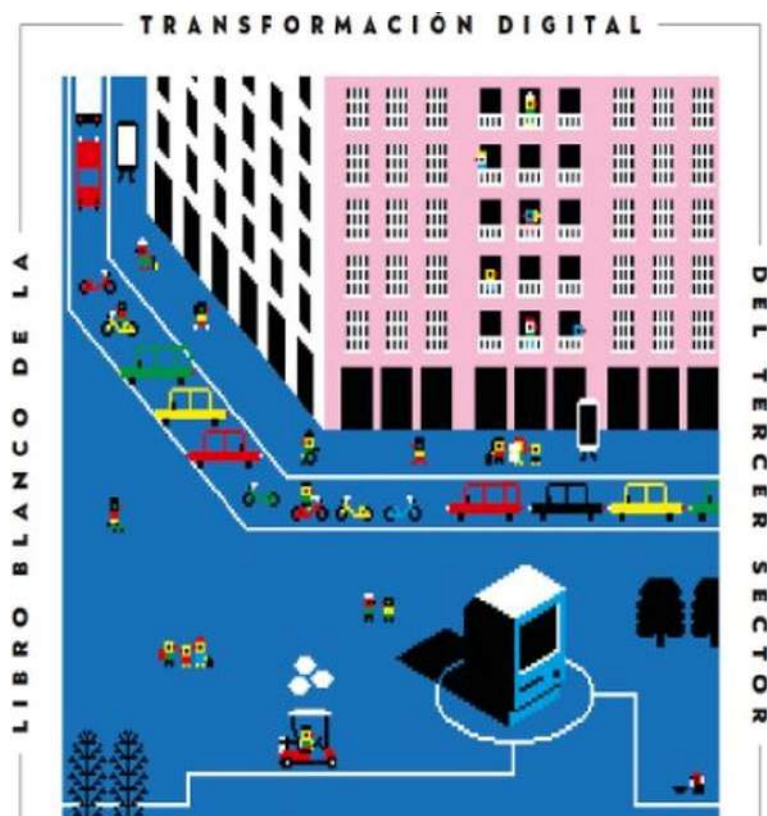

Abstract: On 26 April, part of the team of Adorers Ciudad Real attended a seminar organized by the Women's Institute in Toledo at the Department of Social Welfare to present the results of the research on vicarious violence and minors exposed to gender-based violence. Vicarious violence is violence aimed at harming women through their loved ones, especially their daughters and sons. The father exercises extreme violence against them, even causing their death. The desire to harm his partner or ex-partner at all costs overcomes any affection he may feel for them.

Abstract: We are proud and happy to start the week with news that our campaign "Tambien Es Trata" has been included in the White Book of the Third Sector of Fundación Telefónica, which was presented on May 4th at the headquarters in Madrid. The White Paper aims to be a basic guide for social entities to embark on the path towards the digital transformation of their social action. The publication is based on the social organizations' own experience in the application of technology in their intervention with the rights-holders with whom they work, internal and external communication, and internal coordination, with donors, volunteers, etc. The overall objective of the SpeakingOut "It's Trafficking Too" project together with SICAR cat was to increase knowledge and awareness of forms of exploitation of women and girls that remain hidden and invisible, especially trafficking for the purpose of exploitation in domestic work, trafficking for forced marriage and trafficking for forced criminality. The Digital Transformation White Paper includes a fact sheet on this project, funded by Porticus. Proyecto Esperanza and SICAR cat are currently developing a second part of this project which will continue until the end of 2022. Abstract: A few weeks ago, we had the opportunity to participate in the II Forum "Police Intervention in the field of disability: Hate Crimes and Human Rights" organized by AMIFP. The Association for People with Disabilities of the National Police (AMIFP) defends the rights and interests of people with all types of disabilities and the struggle to improve their quality of life. Our psychologist and Head of Integral Health Iskra Orrillo gave the presentation: Trafficking in Women and Disability; Vulnerability and Invisibility. She gave a brief explanation of the crime of trafficking in women for the purpose of exploitation, the types of trafficking and the conceptualization of trafficking as a violation of human rights and a type of gender violence. It was also explained that trafficked women may also have disability that places them at a higher level of vulnerability. She reflected on the invisibility of this situation. Finally, she shared our proposal to work on Prevention, Detection and Attention.
