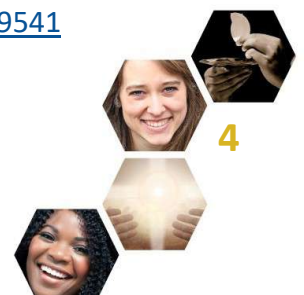

Abstract: Today we present the Sicar Annual Report and a summary of the most relevant data against trafficking in human beings. 2021 was also a year marked by the pandemic and we would like to thank all those who supported our work in this uncertain context. During the last year we assisted 196 people (171 women, 5 men and 20 minors), most of them from Nigeria, Colombia and Venezuela. More than 50% of the people assisted were between 26 and 40 years old. Our legal service was the most used service and responded to 166 people. In addition, 2 women were granted refugee status. These are just some of the many highlights of our report. We ask you to help us reach more people by sharing the publication.

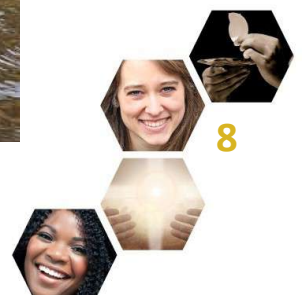

Abstract: Yesterday we had the opportunity to participate in a specialized training with the Prosecutor's Office for Foreigners under the title: WHEN THE MERCHANDISE IS THE HUMAN BEING: TRAFFICKING AND SMUGGLING OF PEOPLE. PRACTICAL ANALYSIS OF THE OFFENCES. It is organized by the Centro de Estudios Jurídicos del Ministerio de Justicia (Centre for Legal Studies of the Ministry of Justice) to whom we are grateful for the invitation. Our colleague and head of #SaludIntegral for victims and survivors of trafficking was able to offer her experience regarding her psychological situation. Psychological damage and consequences. The goal of this activity under the direction of Beatriz Sánchez Álvarez is to be able to:

- To go deeper, from a practical point of view, into the crimes of human trafficking and human smuggling analysis of requirements, modalities, related crimes, differences and similarities between them and with other related crimes.
- To understand and address the difficulties in the investigation and instruction of human trafficking crimes, as well as the peculiarities that must be taken into account when drafting the statement of qualification and adequately preparing the action in the trial, taking into consideration its relationship with transnational organized crime and the idiosyncrasies of the victims of this type of crime.
- Analyse the specific rights of victims of trafficking and the protection measures to be adopted.
- To discuss the current situation, the challenges and the necessary legislative modifications, if any.

Abstract: We share the article that was published a few days ago by El Desalambre de diario.es in relation to the case of the two young women murdered by members of their family in Gurjat, their hometown in Pakistan. We would like to invite you to read the whole article. Here are some paragraphs with ideas that our awareness-raising coordinator Marta Gonzalez contributed:

- These specialized organizations warn of their suspicions that the official figures do not reflect the totality of forced marriages existing in Spain, as it is a reality that is "invisible", "under-reported" and "very little detected", explains Marta González Manchón, awareness and advocacy coordinator of Proyecto Esperanza Adoratrices.
- The fact that this form of male violence comes from within the family, the fear of breaking with community networks and the lack of awareness increase the obstacles to the identification of forced marriages in Spain, she adds.
- These are very complicated cases because there is usually close family and community involvement. These women, some of them teenagers, are in a very complicated situation. They don't want to get married but, on the other hand, they are forced to choose between running away from their family and isolating themselves from their community or submitting to a marriage with all that it entails," says González Manchón, whose organization supports victims of trafficking for the purpose of forced marriage.

Abstract: A few weeks ago, we launched the annual report and it was well received in the media. We wanted to thank you for the support that some of you gave us to spread the document and reach more people. In these 23 years we have assisted 1856 victims of trafficking, of 74 different nationalities, by adopting a human rights, intercultural and gender perspective. Here is one of the key ideas in the form of a statement.

- 269 communications were dealt with in relation to possible cases of trafficking, in 136 of which indications of possible victims of trafficking were detected.
- The Legal Service has assisted 127 women victims of trafficking, facilitating the effective exercise of their rights, access to justice and to a regular administrative situation.
- 23% of the women claiming international protection were granted asylum status.
- Colombia (24.6%) is the country of origin with the highest number of women assisted during 2021, followed by Nigeria (16.6%), Venezuela (8.6%) and Cameroon (8%), among others .

Date: 07/06/2022 **Abstract:** Diana comes from a rural area of Bolivia and is the eldest of 7 siblings. She has a very good relationship with her family and as the eldest sister feels responsible for helping her siblings. Diana moved to the capital of her province because of the economic difficulties they were going through.

First steps in her country

- She made her way as a singer, going from village to village, giving concerts at fairs and singing at weddings and other events. She became more and more known in her area and had numerous requests for performances, which allowed her to earn some money and help her family.
- She set up a profile on the social network Facebook to use her professionally, posting videos of her performances to make herself known and increase her chances of being hired for different events.

Social network as a recruiting tool for the trafficker

- A Bolivian man named Raúl, who lives in Spain, contacted her through Facebook. He frequently wrote to her congratulating her on her work, acted like an admirer and behaved in a respectful and formal manner.

False promises

- After several months of exchanging messages, he began to encourage her to come to Europe. He told her that he had been living in Spain for many years and that he had a good position as he worked as an engineer. He told her that he could help her, that he had a friend who offered to shoot a quality promotional video for her and that this would help her to progress in her career. Travel and move to Spain.
- Diana had many doubts as she had never thought of going abroad, but Raul gradually overcame her fears and misgivings and offered to pay for her ticket, put her up in his house and support her. Finally, Diana took the plunge, thinking it was an opportunity she should seize for the sake of her family and that she would have nothing to lose by trying.

Abstract: In these 23 years, we have made progress by joining forces with an extensive network of alliances. Proyecto Esperanza has contributed to the fight against trafficking in Spain in recent years, contributing its analysis, reflections and proposals, together with numerous institutions and social agents. Our efforts have mainly focused on:

- Raising awareness of human trafficking as a serious violation of human rights.
- Highlighting the obligation of States to act diligently and proactively to prevent the crime and, where appropriate, to protect, repair and compensate the victims.
- To make visible the situation of special vulnerability of victims of trafficking who are undocumented foreigners, international protection seekers, persons with disabilities and minors.
- To contribute to avoid the re-victimization of survivors of trafficking, especially in criminal proceedings, and to ensure their effective legal redress and compensation.

Abstract: We would like to congratulate Wanawake Mujer for the space they opened last Friday together with the firm Camila with the aim of promoting the inclusion of vulnerable women. Our Person in charge of direct intervention, Carmen Bruñó, was able to share this important moment of the creation of the space "Maua, flowers for equality", located in the shopping center in Las Rozas, which has the collaboration of La Caixa Foundation, and will serve to promote the social and labour inclusion of women survivors of trafficking.

- Thanks to this initiative, one woman has been hired on a permanent basis and five more are being trained in a pre-employment workshop with beneficiaries of Proyecto Esperanza. Thus, the project will offer social and labour inclusion to these six women, in a situation of extreme vulnerability, and who are survivors of trafficking for the purpose of exploitation.
- In the premises lent by Carmila until the end of the year, it will be possible to purchase the handmade pieces made with materials such as glass or textiles, which will be unique, original and cheerful. With the profits from the sale of these items, Wanawake works to improve the living conditions of women in Kenya and Tanzania, most of whom are survivors of female genital mutilation (FGM), child marriage (IM) and trafficking for exploitation (TFE).
- More than 40 women in these two African countries are part of this project and achieve through it a work that gives them a voice, visibility, and above all, decision-making power over their lives and the lives of their daughters. And more than 30 women have gone through the pre-employment workshop, which together with our institution we help them in their process of recovery and social insertion.
