

Abstract: Yesterday the whole Proyecto Esperanza team met to share the strategic priorities for the coming months. We are aligning our work with the strategic dimensions identified in the joint work we did as a whole Welfare Project with a view to obtaining the EFQM quality seal last year. We are reflecting on working with profiles of victims of other forms of trafficking that are even more invisible than sexual exploitation, we will prioritize making a digital leap that includes both equipment and skills in the team and we are reviewing the processes and indicators to make them more streamlined, always seeking to connect theory with practice. We have also decided to spend the second part of the morning sharing together, with the rest of the team, the last group supervision session of the team. This work is part of the proposals of the Internal Protection System and has been accompanied by an external professional, Carlos Albares. We seek to continue generating safe and caring environments and this specific work focuses on the care of the professionals who are in charge of the task. We are about to start the holiday season and this meeting has been a turning point that has allowed us both to look back, compiling and becoming aware of achievements and improvements made, as well as to look ahead, facing the exciting future that awaits us after the holidays.
