

Abstract: Last week we participated in Brussels in the final meeting of the European programme "Strengthening support and protection systems for victims of human trafficking in Europe", led by the private philanthropic organization @Porticus, in which 27 organizations from 8 European countries have participated.

At the Brussels meeting we were able to share the learnings in the framework of the project Speaking Out También Es Trata, implemented together with @SICARcat between July 2019 and June 2021.



The aim of this project was to influence regulations, public policies and protocols for action against human trafficking in Spain to ensure protection and access to rights for trafficked women and girls, especially for those exploitation purposes (in forced labour or services in domestic employment, for forced criminality and for forced marriages) that have remained invisible and under-detected.

The Speaking Out #TambienEsTrata project was chosen by the AVANCE consultancy to carry out a case study on structural changes in protection and support systems for victims of human trafficking to which the project of Porticus has contributed.

The meeting also served to carry out advocacy at regional level through dialogue with Members of the European Parliament Mr Juan Fernando López Aguilar (President of the Committee on Civil Liberties, Justice and Home Affairs) and Ms María Soraya Rodríguez Ramos (Member of the Committee on Women's Rights and Gender Equality).

Currently Proyecto Esperanza and SICAR cat are implementing the project Speaking Out II, which aims to give continuity and deepen the main issues related to access to rights of lesser known victims of trafficking for exploitative purposes, as well as the participation of victims and survivors of trafficking.
