

According to the #InformeTIP2022, in Spain, traffickers exploit foreign victims and, to a lesser extent, Spanish victims in state and foreign territory.


The pandemic increased labor traffic, especially in agriculture, domestic work, and cannabis cultivation in Catalonia .

Ukrainian refugees, especially women and children fleeing war, are vulnerable to human trafficking

The report also makes some recommendations to Spain such as:

- Investigations, trials, and convictions for traffic crimes, particularly for forced labor, are increasing.
- Allow formal identification of victims without requiring law enforcement interaction .





Abstract: The Group of Experts in Action against Trafficking in Human Beings (GRETA) of the Council of Europe published its annual report for 2021 on July 13.

In 2021, GRETA was able to achieve several milestones despite the negative impact of the Covid-19 pandemic and continued to develop its cooperation with other Council of Europe bodies, other international organizations, and civil society to prevent and combat human trafficking.

In the report, GRETA President Helga Gayer emphasizes that child trafficking has continued to increase despite legislative and policy measures taken by states parties to the anti-trafficking convention. "The Covid-19 pandemic has made children even more vulnerable to trafficking, including exploitation via the internet.



All actors involved in action against human trafficking must step up efforts to combat child trafficking and develop innovative approaches to protect children," he said.

on online and technology-enabled trafficking in human beings based on information provided by 40 States parties to the Council of Europe Convention on Combating Trafficking in Human Beings. human resources, 12 NGOs, and two information technology companies.

The study assesses the extent to which technology affects human trafficking, the operational and legal challenges in detecting, investigating, and prosecuting online and ICT-facilitated human trafficking crimes, and contains a set of recommendations.

These include internet monitoring, web scraping tools, and social media analytics. The participation and cooperation of a wide range of agencies and the sharing of knowledge are crucial, as is cross-border cooperation to obtain electronic evidence.

Several victims of trafficking for sexual exploitation were identified in 201 (136), victims of trafficking for labor exploitation (51), and patra MF (2). In 2021, no victims of trafficking have been identified for the commission of criminal activities or for begging.

We need to continue reinforcing the cooperation work to increase the identification of the most underdetected cases of trafficking.

This year, the theme adopted by the United Nations on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) is related to the use and abuse of technologies, since the results revealed by the report of November 3, 2021, showed that the victims are seen affected by criminal practices on the internet.
