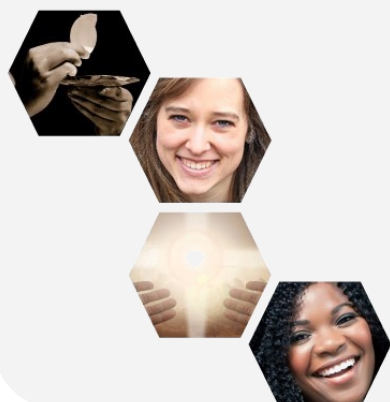

Abstract: The Congregation of Religious Adorers Handmaids of the Blessed Sacrament and Charity was founded in 1856 by Saint María Micaela to respond to a latent problem in society at that time: to help young women who were victims of social exclusion, many of them involved in the world of trafficking, prostitution, violence among the couple, or other social problems that have appeared over the years.

Abstract: We start this week remembering the press clipping on the occasion of July 30 about our project #TambienEsTrata. We thank Celeste López for her approach and sensitivity to this problem.

We highlight some paragraphs of the article that you can read in the link.

Combating human trafficking has become one of the priorities of the United Nations Organization (UN), numerous states, and social and humanitarian entities around the world. But, as all of them insist, trafficking (a new term to define slavery) is not only that linked to sexual exploitation and on which all attention falls at this time. Yes, it is the most numerous and possibly the one that generates huge profits for the mafias of human beings, but others are made invisible, which makes it impossible to fight them.

“The consequences of these crimes on their victims are profound and reach all areas of their personal and, therefore, they need comprehensive care that allows them to regain control over their own lives. It is essential that these other forms of exploitation are recognized by main persons, and that their ability to detect them is strengthened. It is also necessary to create intersectoral alliances that favor the detection of cases to refer them to specialized services,” says Marta González, the Coordinator of Sensibilization of Project Esperanza.

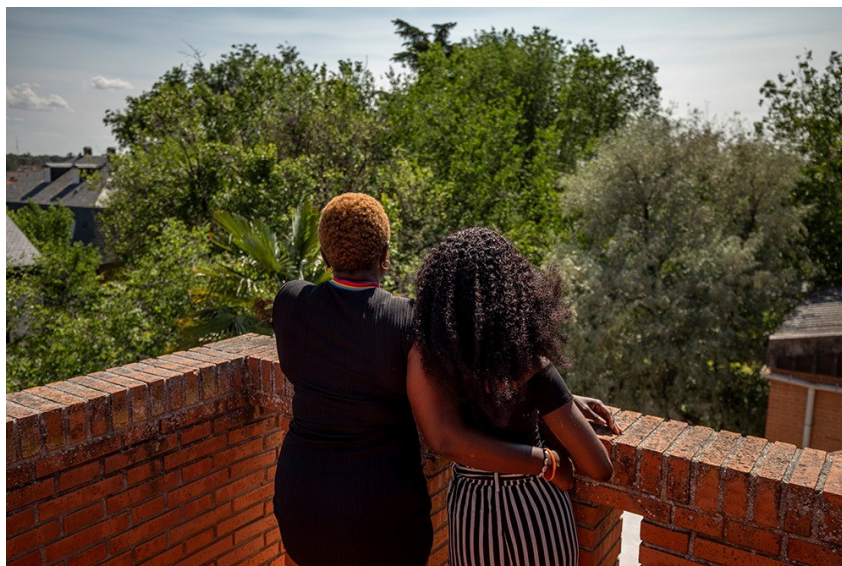

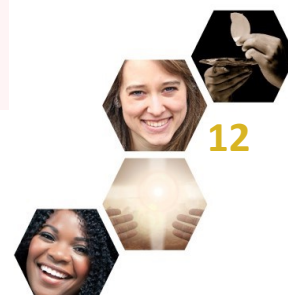

Lola Ferri Hidalgo, a lawyer from the Amaranta Solidarity Foundation, has been collaborating for 10 years as a teacher of the same. The professor of Constitutional Law Benito Aláez was in charge of giving the inaugural conference, in which he analyzed the preliminary draft of the Asturian law of childhood. The act was also attended by the head of the Ministry of Social Rights and Welfare, Melania Álvarez, and different personalities linked to the University of Oviedo.

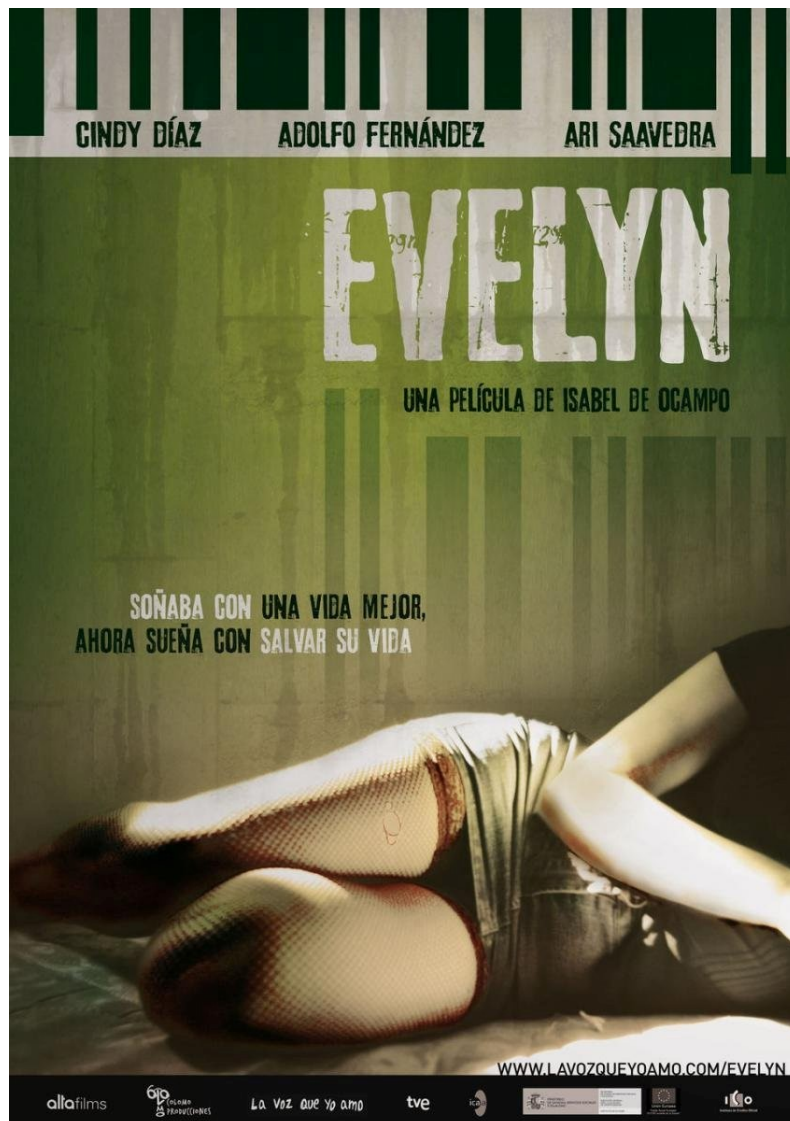

Title: No news of the anti-trafficking law: does the government have time to approve it?

Abstract: Five months have passed since the Minister of Justice, Pilar Llop, announced the start-up of work for the elaboration of a comprehensive law against trafficking: more than 150 days later there is no news of the legal text, although her ministry they deny that the project has been parked and they assure that they are working "intensely" on it.

Title: The cry of 'Only yes is yes' became law.

Abstract: Last Thursday, August 25, 2022, the plenary session of Congress definitively approved the so-called law of the only yes is yes. Its processing has been long and has not been without controversy. The norm changes the paradigm of sexual violence and responds to a feminist clamor that was formed from the sentence of the rape committed by "the herd" in the Sanfermines of 2016, in which sexual abuse and not aggression was considered, and which triggered a wave of demonstrations throughout the Spanish state. The text went ahead with 205 votes in favor, 141 against, and 3 abstentions.
