Abstract: Last Wednesday we had a meeting with the judge Ms. Alicia Eguren Prieto, assigned to the Court of Violence against Women No. 1 of Arganda del Rey.

The meeting was also attended by two representatives of the General Directorate of Equality of the Community of Madrid, and we presented the comprehensive care service for women victims of trafficking for sexual exploitation that we manage within the network of women's centers.

- This visit is part of the collaboration program of the DGI General of the Community of Madrid in the field of training with the General Council of Judicial Power and involves an explanation of our Network of Comprehensive Care for Gender Violence and a subsequent visit to some of the services.
- The aim of the visit, as on previous occasions, is to explain the characteristics of the services, the situations of the women we attend to at the Centre and to facilitate direct contact with the team of professionals in order to gain direct knowledge of the work we carry out and to exchange and share all our concerns and issues to continue to improve in terms of identification, protection, recovery and compensation for victims of trafficking.

We are grateful for the opportunity to collaborate with the regional administration of Madrid and with a member of the judiciary assigned to a criminal court with exclusive jurisdiction over violence against women.

Abstract: Today we want to bring you new data on slavery, forced labour and forced marriage thanks to the joint report of ILO IOM and walk free published last September.

The 2021 Global Estimates reveal that, at any point in the reporting period between 2017 and 2021, 50 million people were victims of modern slavery, either forced to work against their will or to live in a marriage without their agreement. This figure means that almost one in 150 people in the world is in this terrible situation.

- Forced labour and forced marriage have increased significantly in the last five years.
- Forced labour is of concern regardless of a country's wealth.
- Slavery knows no country. 52% of all forced labour and 1/4 of all forced marriages are found in upper-middle or high-income countries.
- Most cases of forced labour (86%) are in the private sector. Nearly one in eight forced labourers are children. More than half are in commercial sexual exploitation.
- An estimated 22 million people are victims of forced marriage. More than two thirds of those forced into marriage are women.

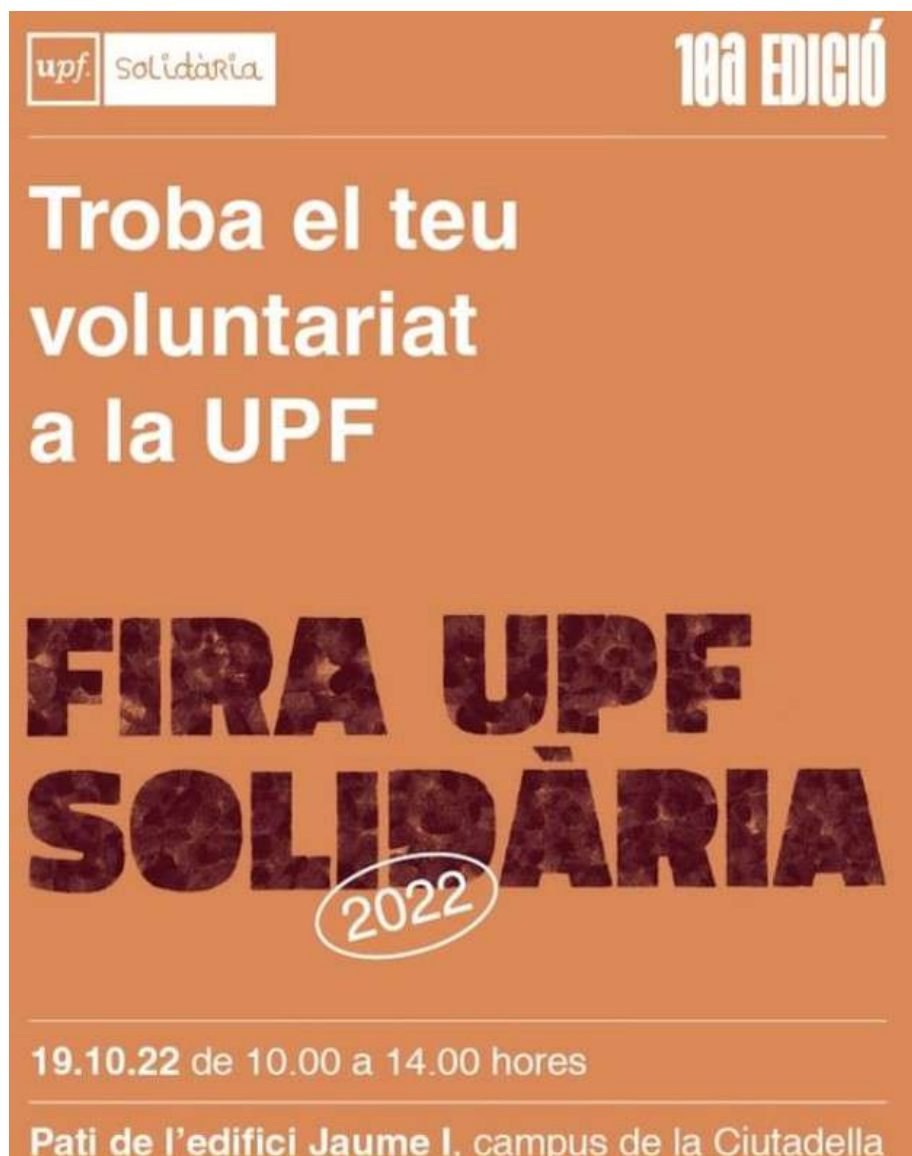

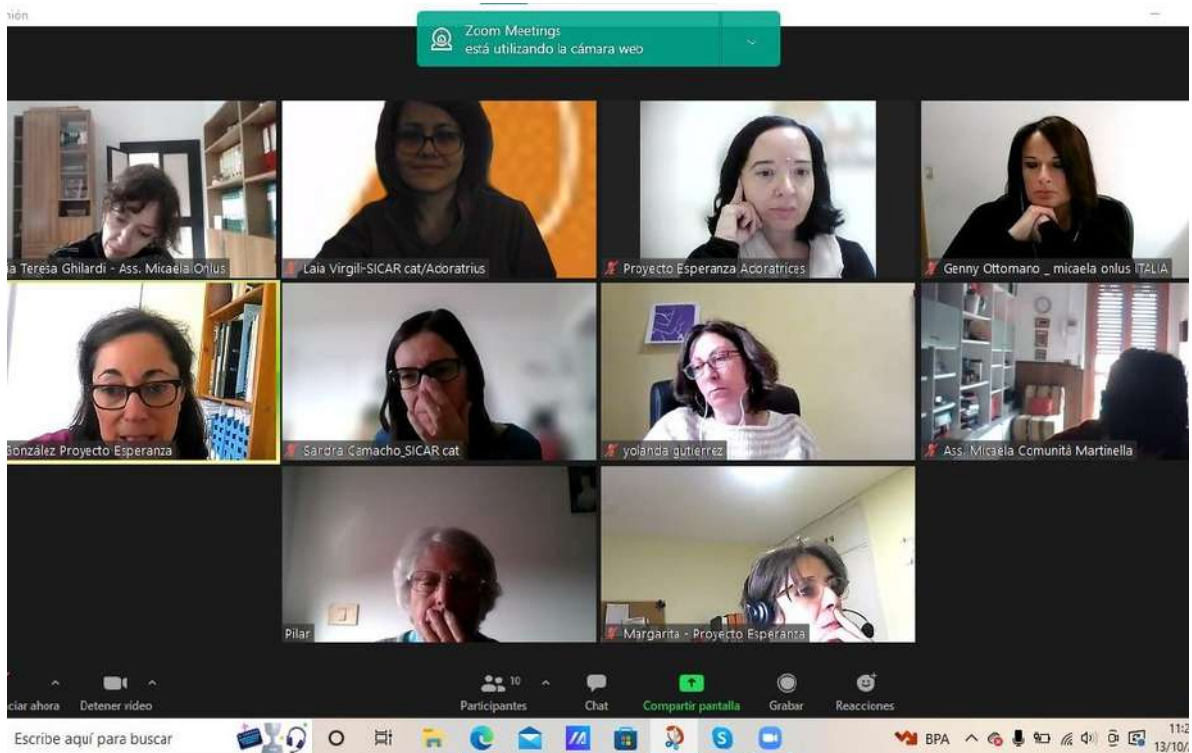

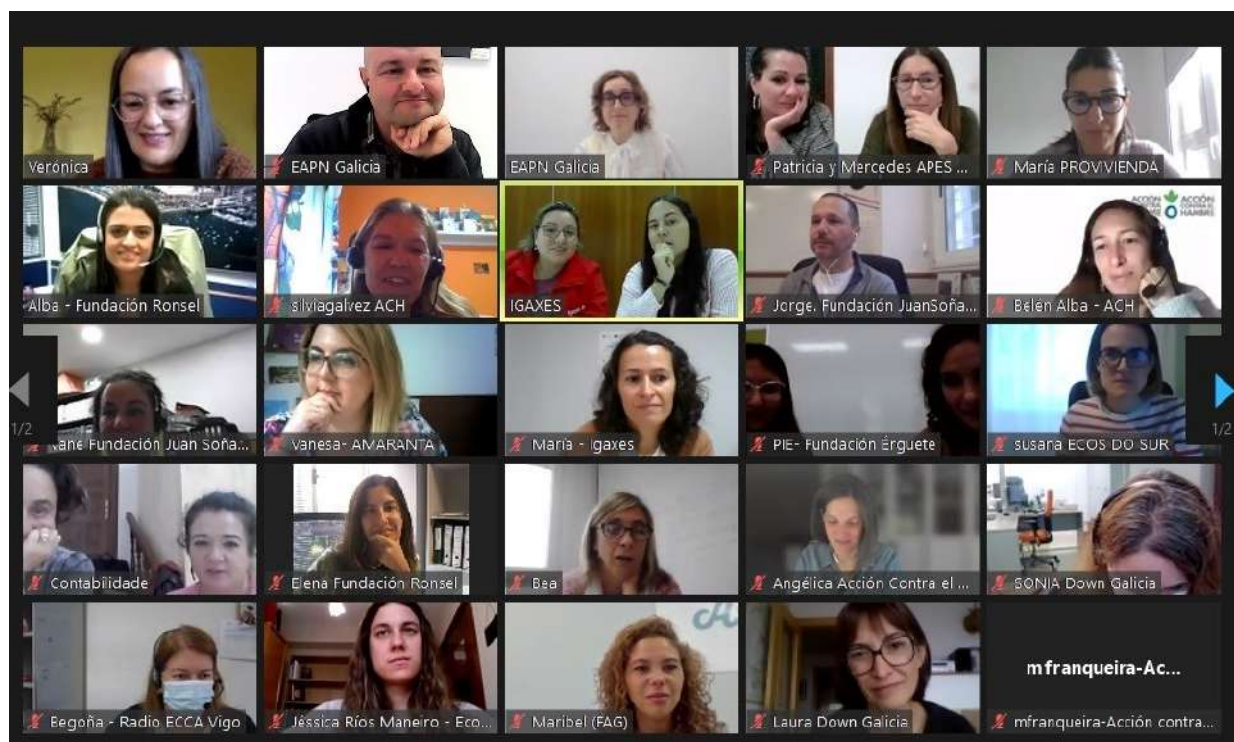
