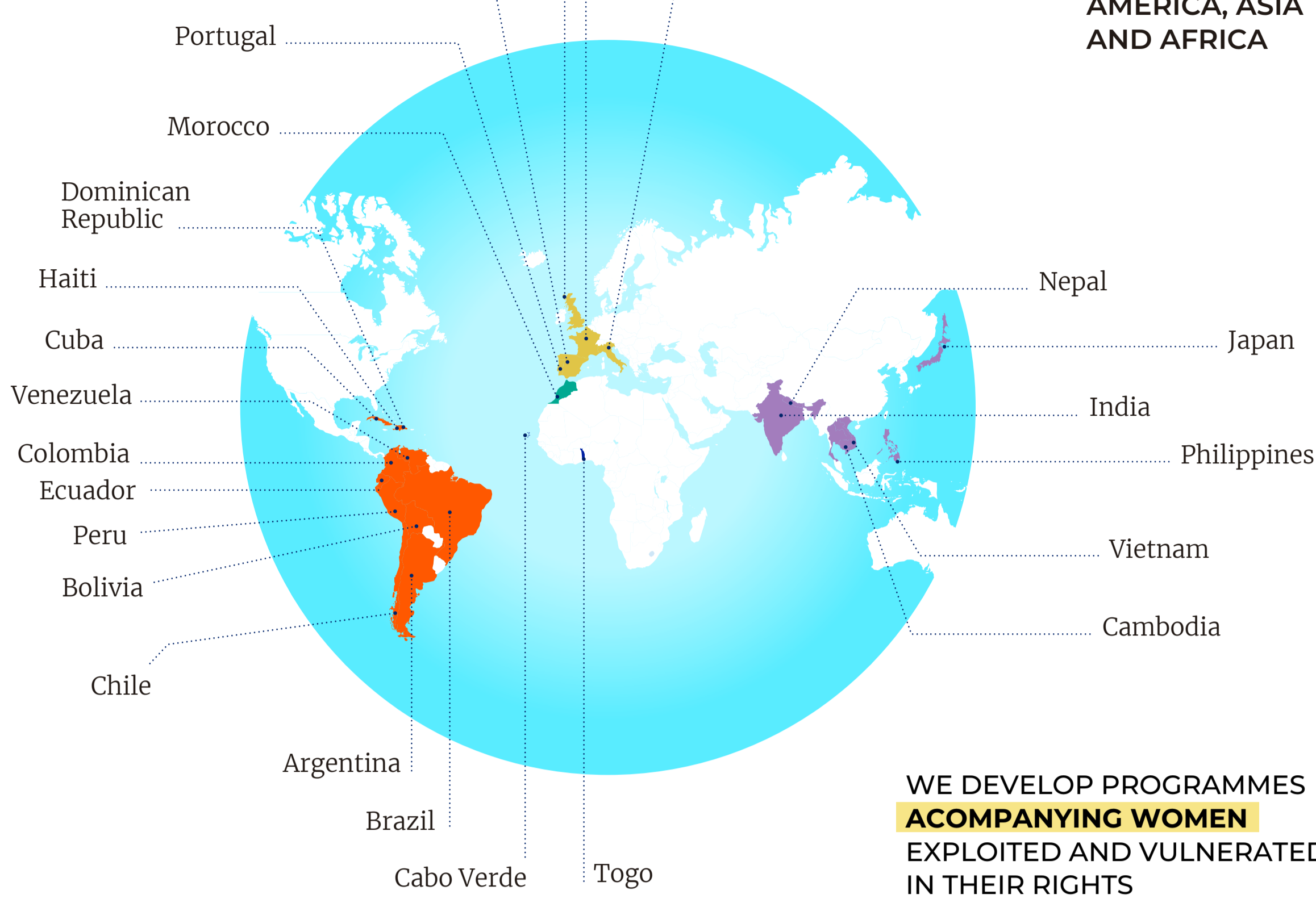


We are an international religious congregation founded by Saint Maria Micaela. **We accompany women** who have suffered exploitation, violence and other situations of exclusion.

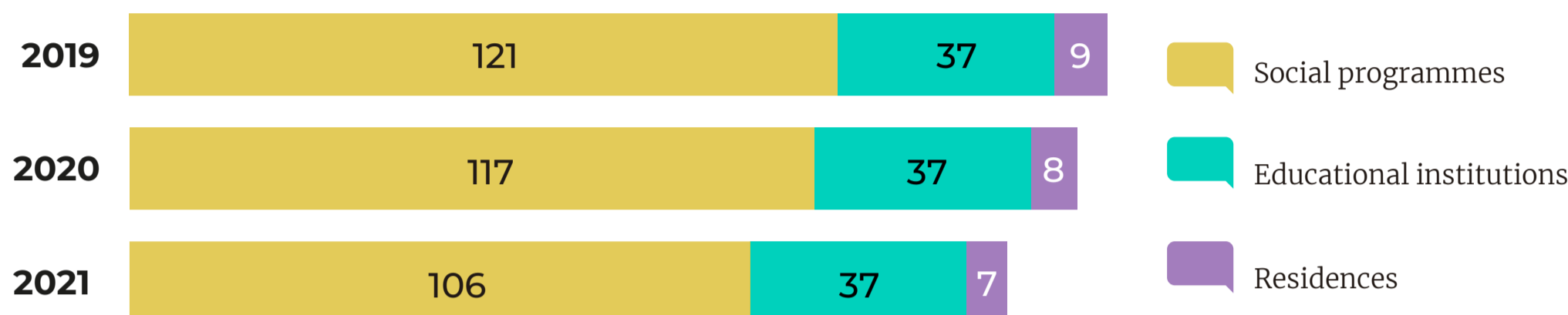
The intervention is carried out through **three major actions:**

Social Programmes: We offer training and alternative solutions to women in situations of prostitution or victims of trafficking.

Educational Institutions: We impart education and training in values to children and adolescents, giving priority to those who come from the most vulnerable contexts.

Residences: Spaces that facilitate training in solidarity values for young university students or workers.

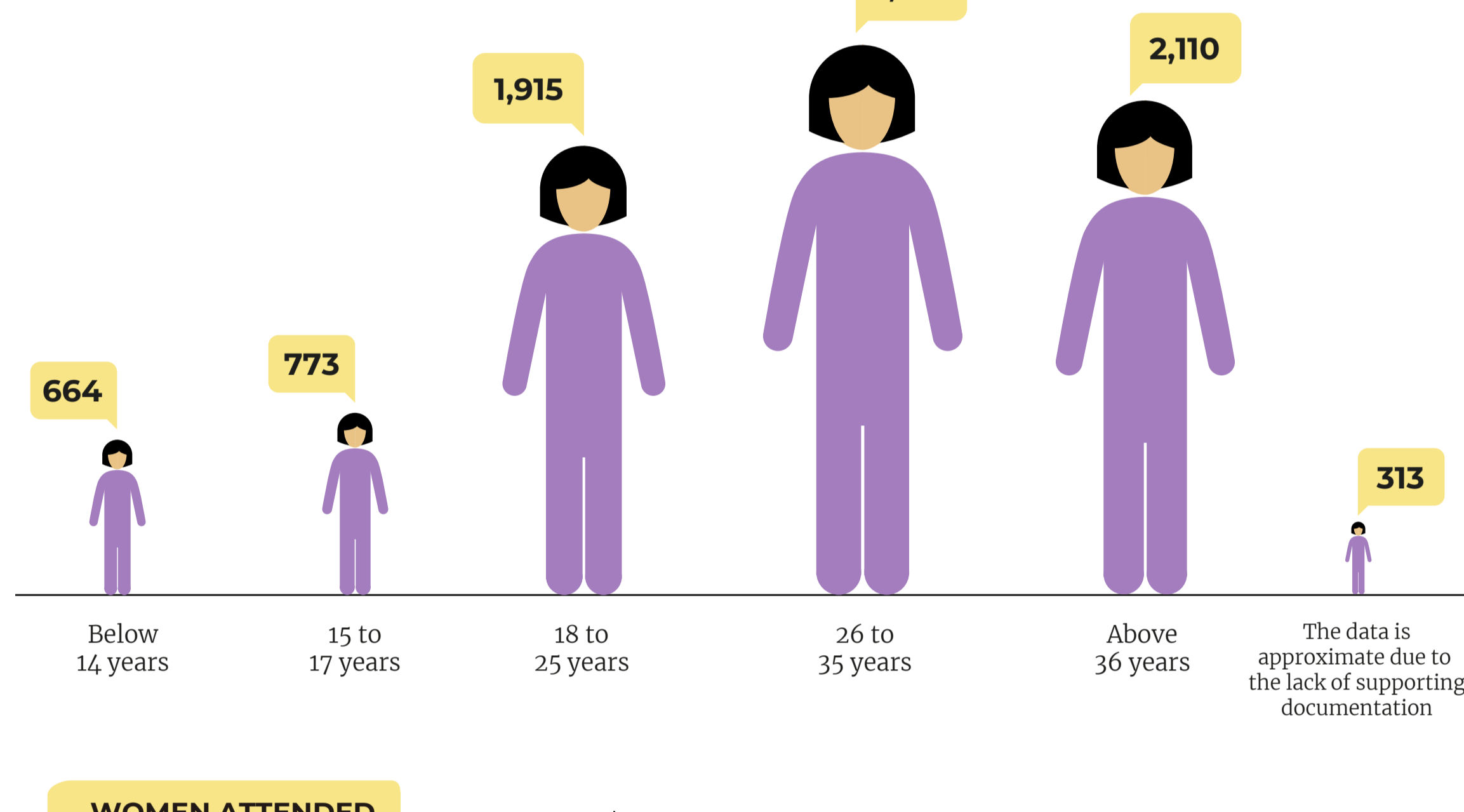
COMPARISON OF THE 3 LAST YEARS

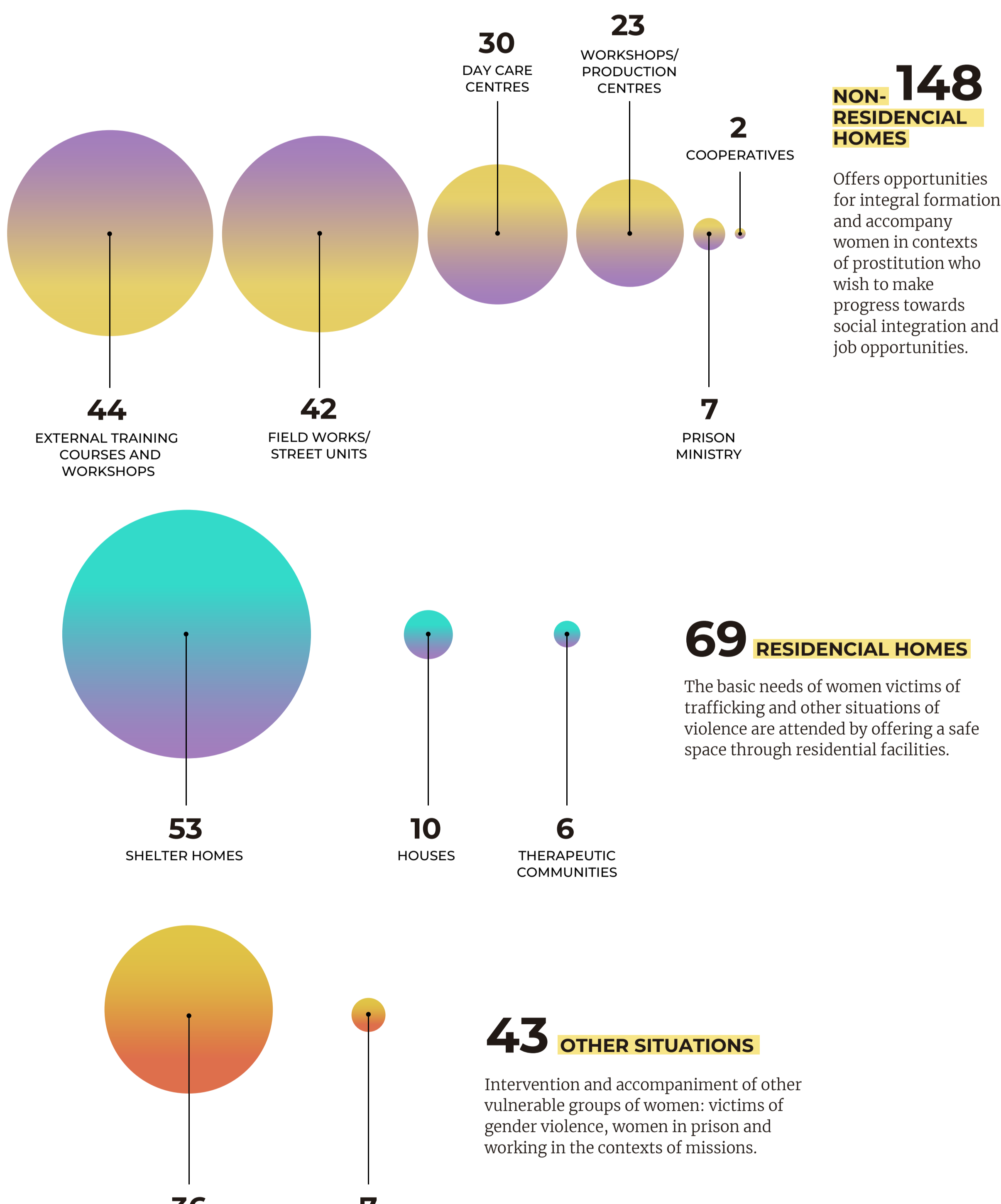
