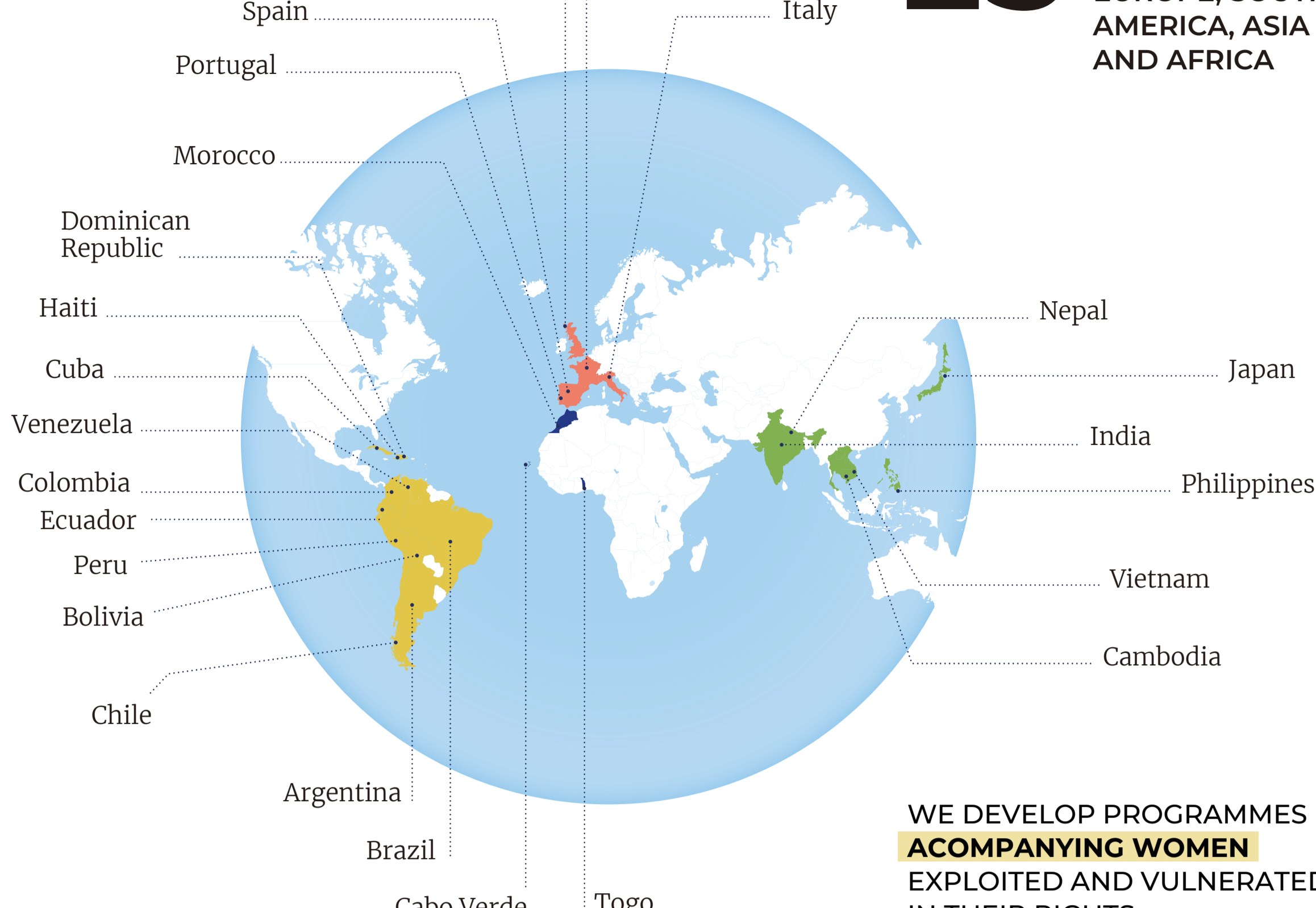


We are an international religious congregation founded by Saint Maria Micaela. **We accompany women** who have suffered exploitation, violence and other situations of exclusion.

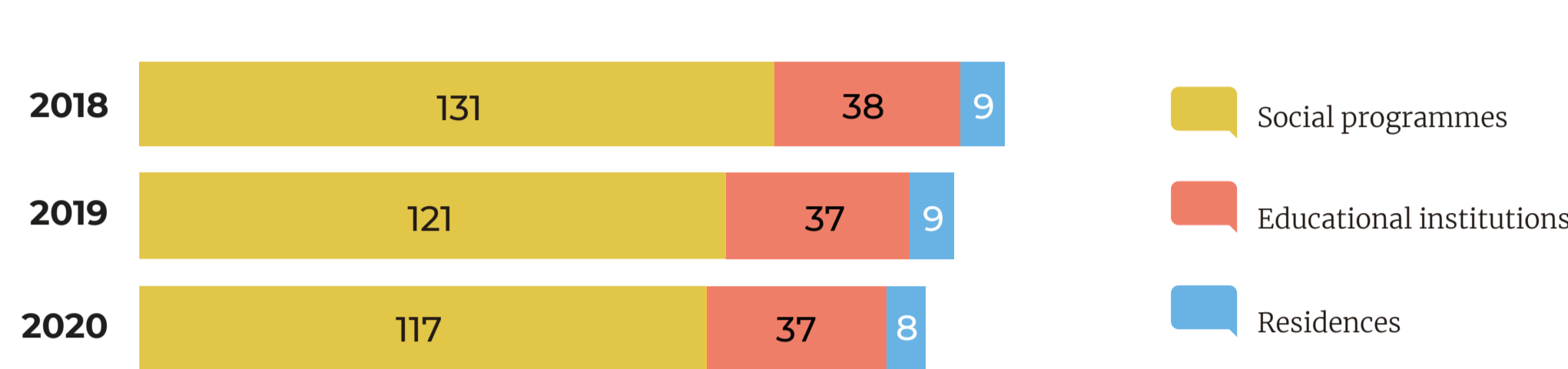
The intervention is carried out through **three major actions:**

**Educational Institutions:** We provide education and training on values to children and adolescents, giving priority to the vulnerable population.

**Residences:** Facilitate training programmes on values and solidarity for university students and working girls.

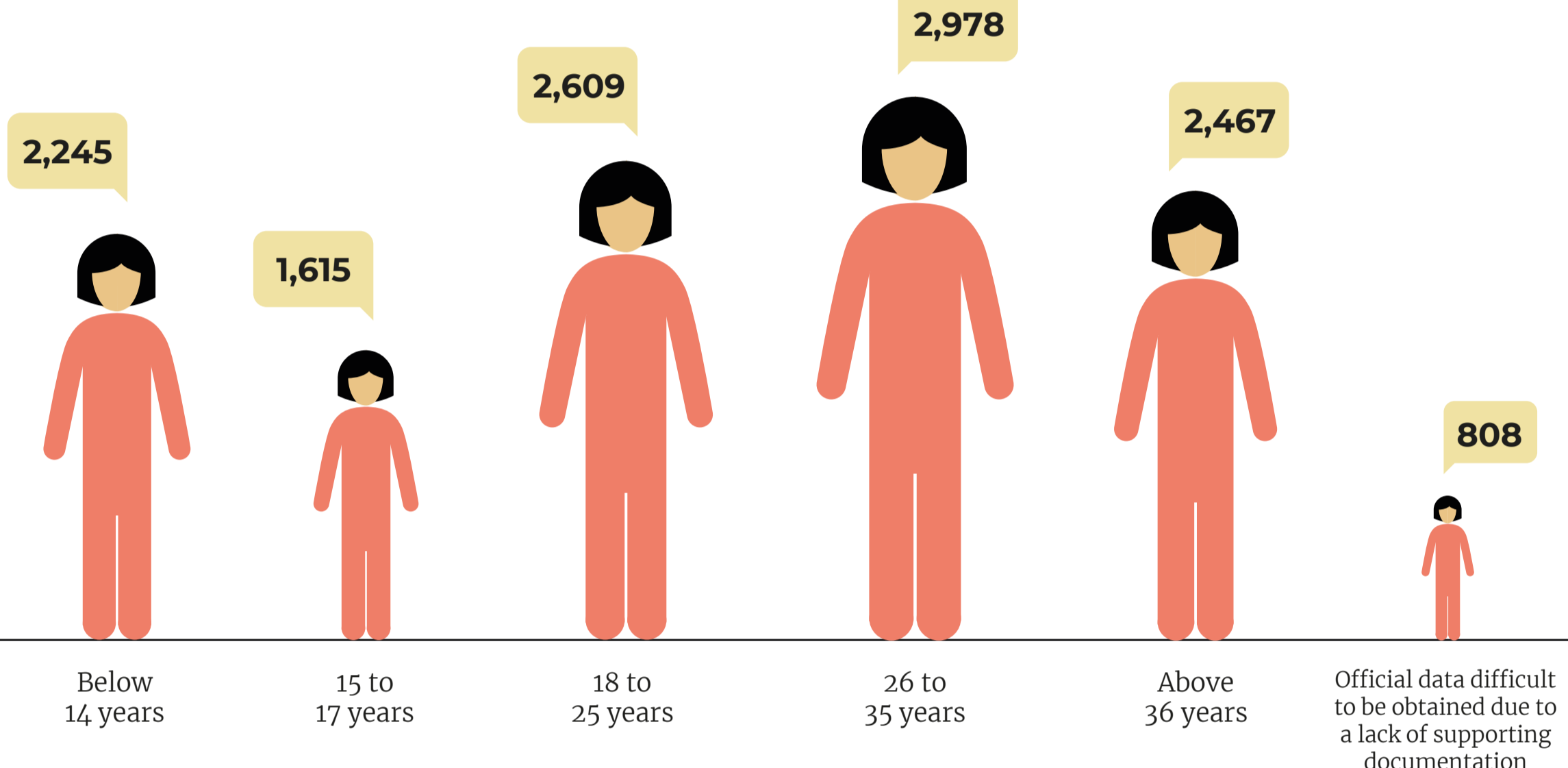
## COMPARISON OF THE 3 LAST YEARS



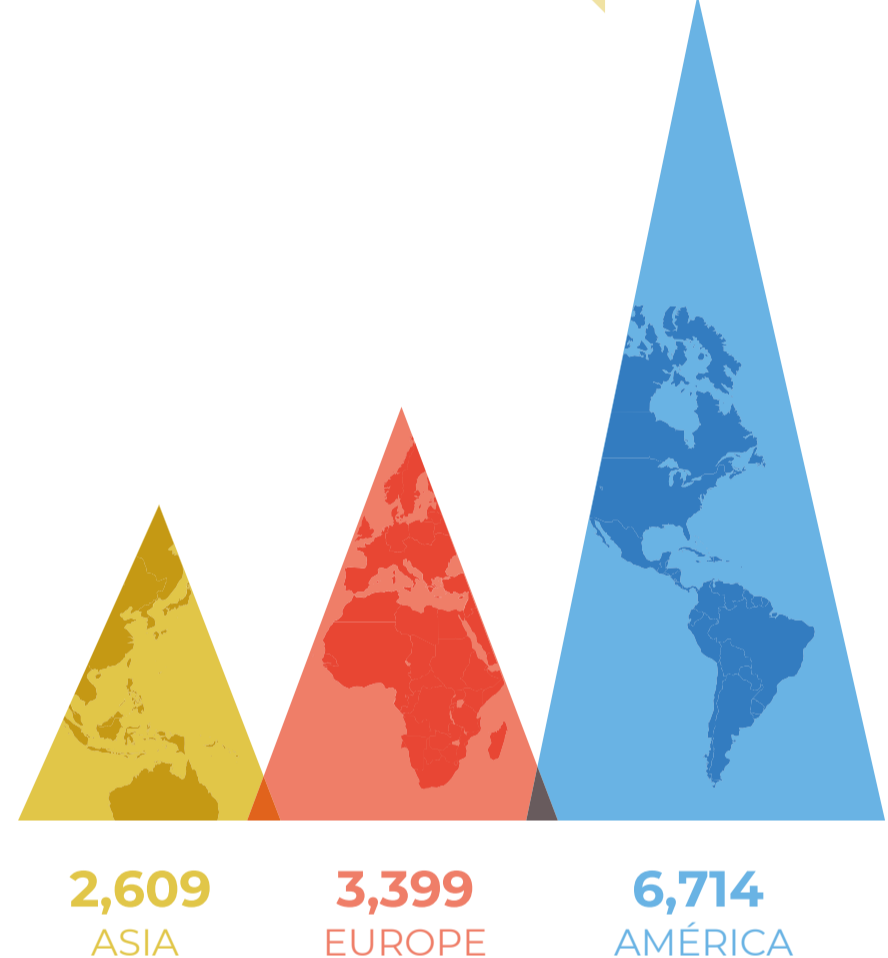
## SISTERS ADORERS' SOCIAL WORK

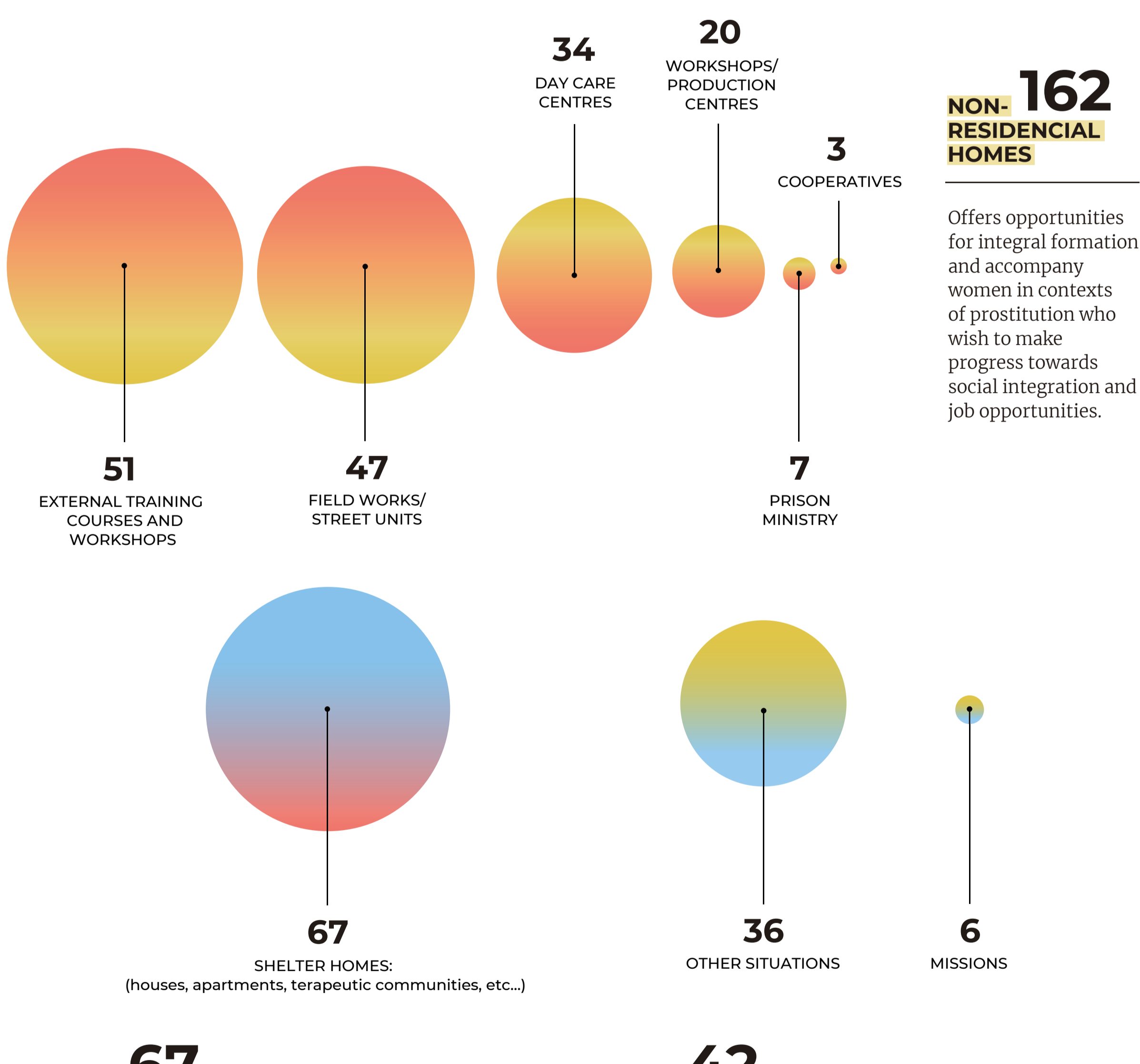

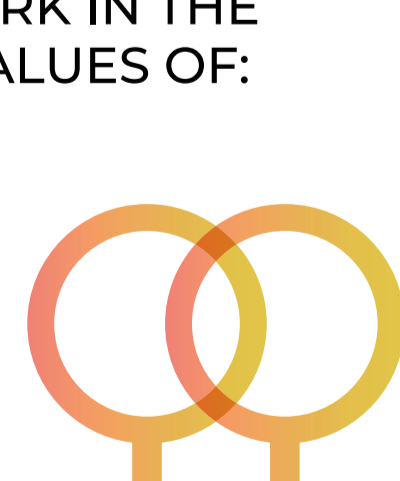
The basic needs of women victims of trafficking and other situations of violence are attended by offering a safe space through residential facilities.
