Sister Teresa Valenzuela, the Superior General, began her pastoral visit to the Adorers' province of Calcutta (India) on the 17th of October 2022.

Her first visit was to the community of New Delhi where five sisters work with adolescents at risk of prostitution. Then she visited the community in Punjab where three Adorers also work for the prevention of trafficking situations and, finally, she visited the Nazareth Villa community in Calcutta. Five sisters run a hostel for university students with a capacity for 80 young students and they support a project run by the Provincial house community where they work for the women in prostitution. They give training workshops in aesthetics, dressmaking and basic literacy.

Sister Fara Galati, one of the general councillors, joined Sister Teresa's pastoral visit. Both will be in Calcutta Province until 20th December, and then they will travel to Bombay Province, where they will meet the Provincial Superior and her council, stay for a week and celebrate Christmas. They will then go to Nepal, Vietnam and Cambodia until 4th January 2023 when they will return to Rome.
