

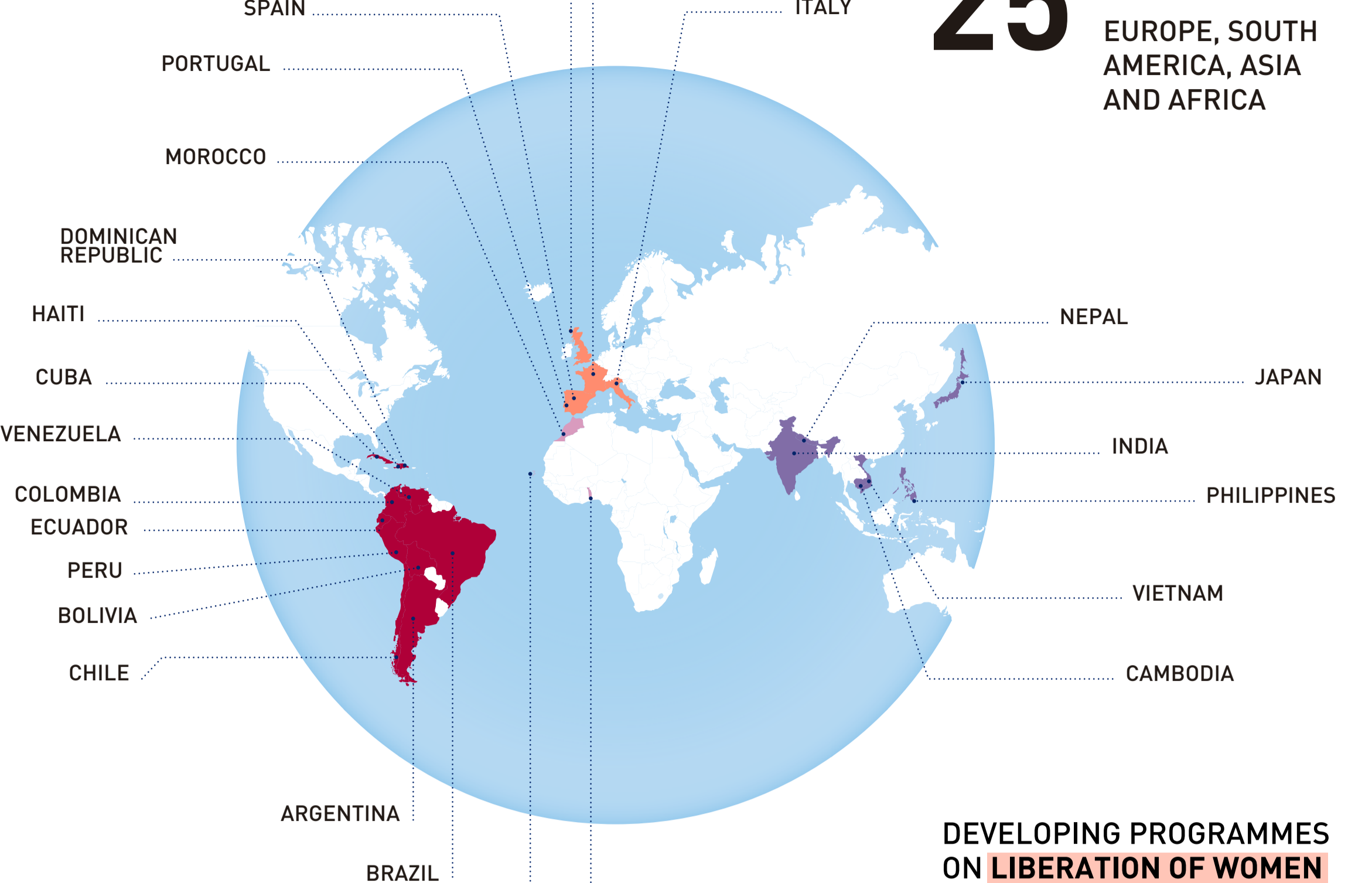

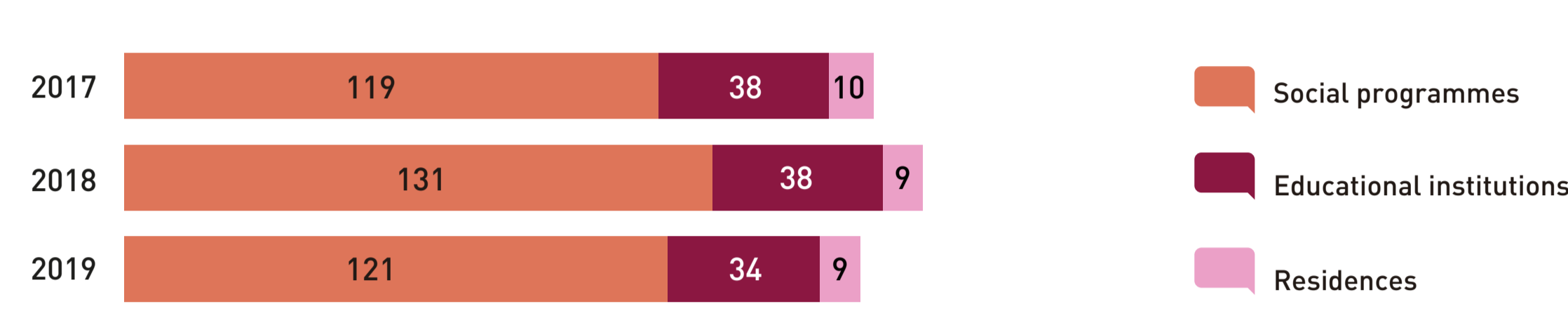
We carry out our intervention through **three major actions**:

Residences: Facilitate training programmes on values and solidarity for university students and working girls.

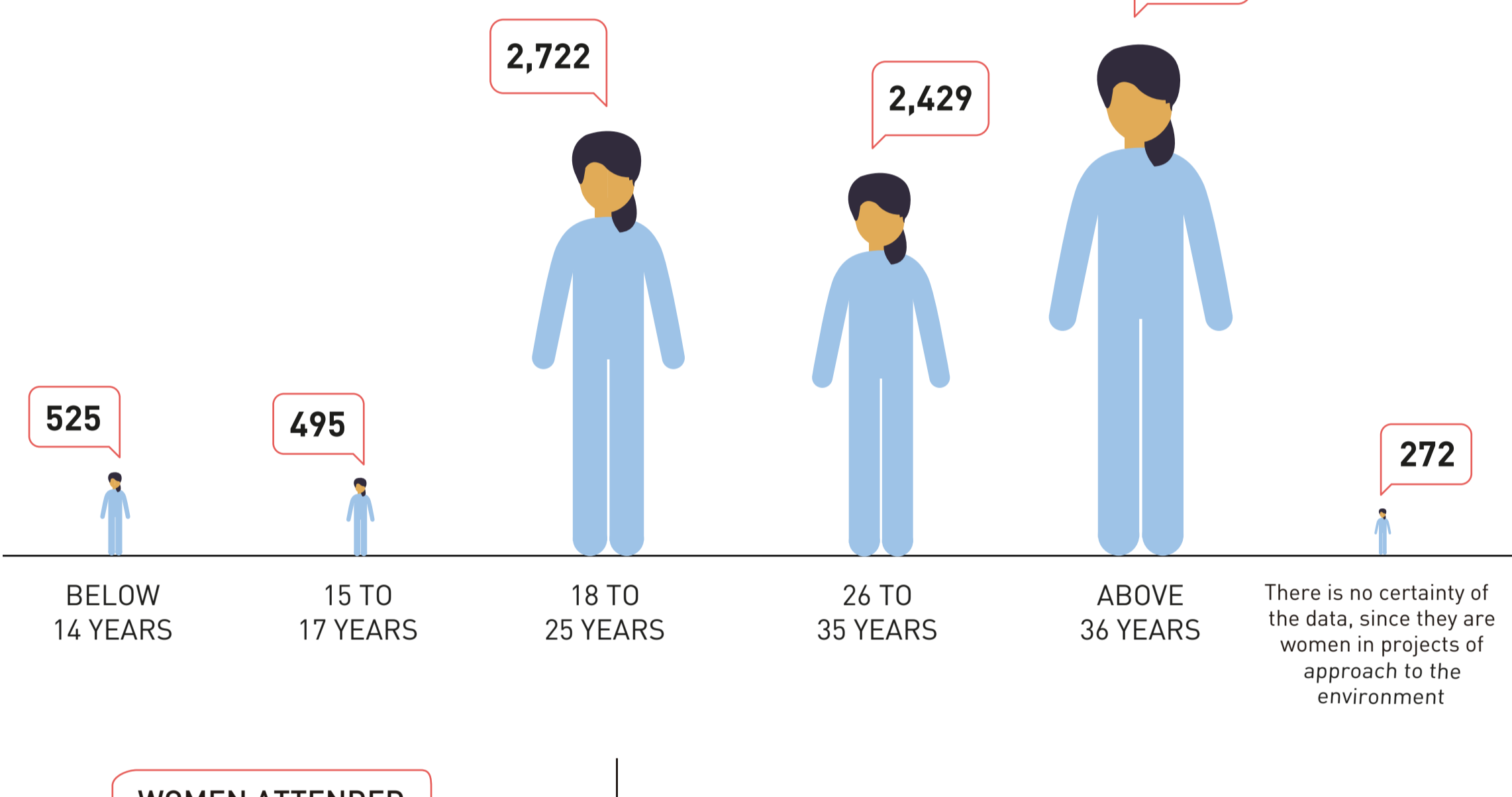
COMPARISON OF THE 3 LAST YEARS



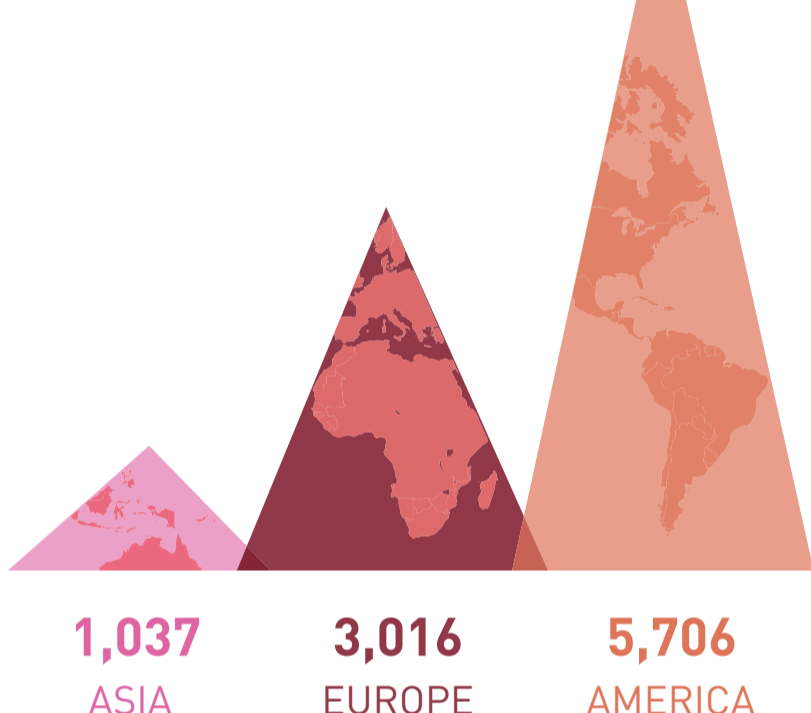
SISTERS ADORERS' SOCIAL WORK

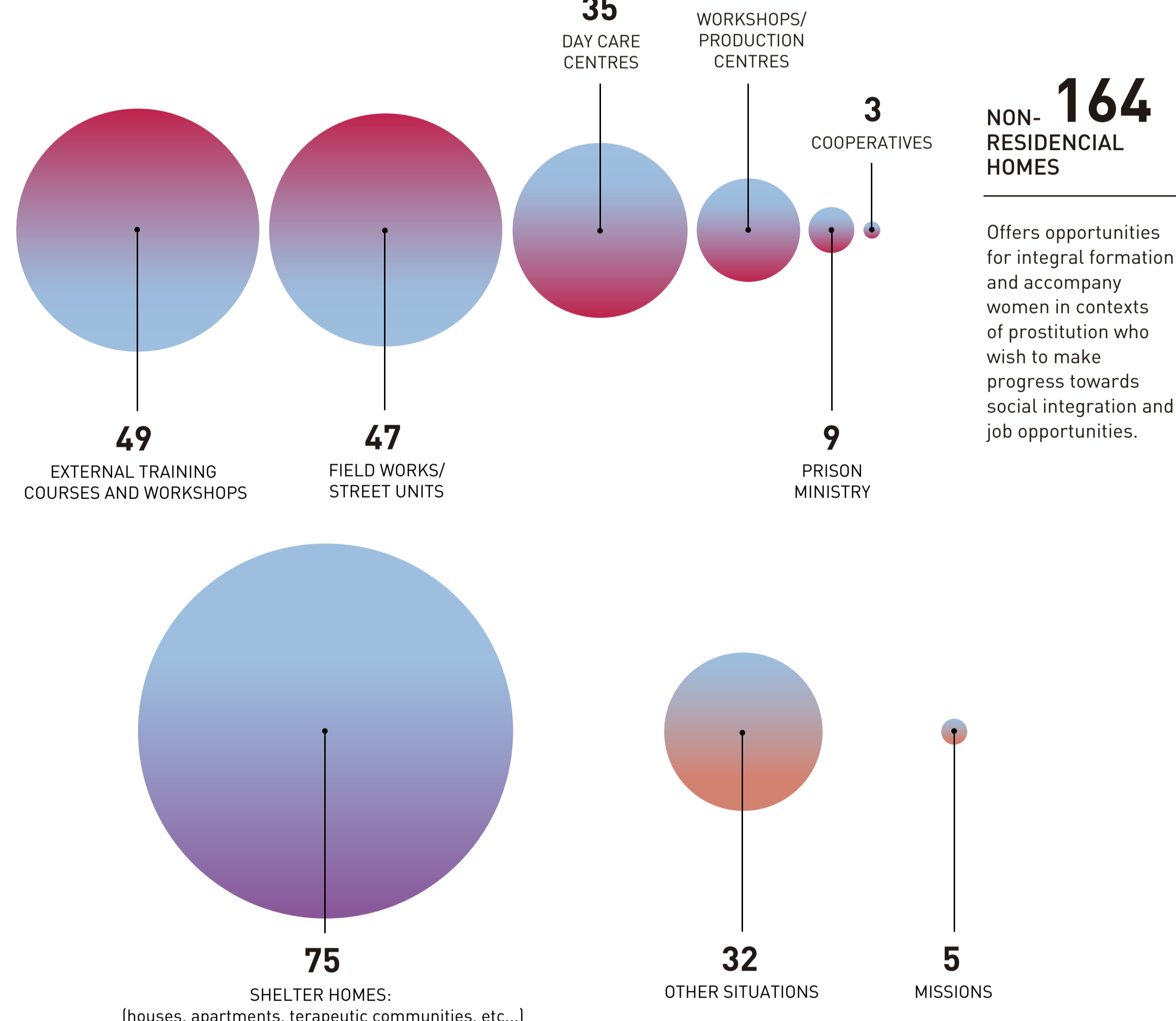

We serve women who are victims of trafficking and other hostile situations and we collaborate with other institutions to meet their basic needs and conditions of safety and security.

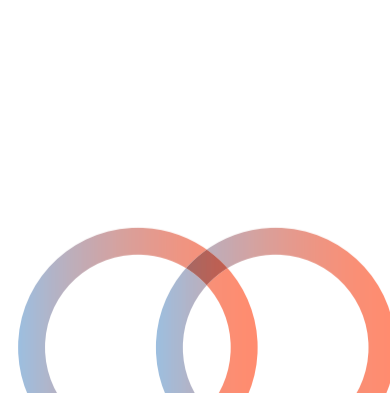

Intervention and accompaniment of other vulnerable groups of women: victims of gender violence, women in prison and working in the contexts of missions.



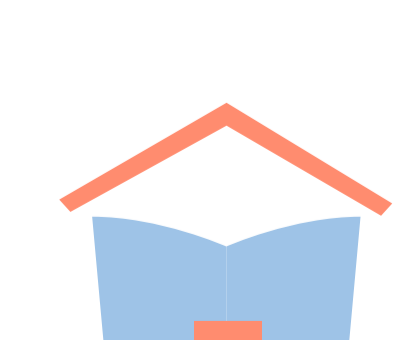
